President's Message

Greetings fellow alumni and friends of Saint Augustine's College! This is an exciting time of the year for our beloved Alma Mater. We can always point our fingers to areas needing improvement at our school, but oh, how exciting it is to see things that are moving in the right direction.

As of the writing of this communication, our football team is still undefeated. We are scheduled to have a groundbreaking ceremony on the George Williams Athletic Complex in a few days. Communication and cooperation among the major "stakeholders" of the college are much improved and getting better as time goes by. Student enrollment may be slightly down, but the "outward appearance" of the student body was most impressive to this alumnus during the recent Fall Convocation. Academic probation is not an issue, and we reportedly ended the year financially in the "black." Alumni Annual Giving is not what it should be, but we're giving more now than we've given in recent years. A new Falcon National Booster Club of Saint Augustine's College has been organized under the leadership of Robert "Butch" Williams, and the Falcon Foundation is continuing its legacy and mission of supporting the Athletic programs as well. A lot of good things are happening at our Alma Mater.

I, like some of you have my concerns about some aspects of the college, just as I do about my church, family and community. However, I have chosen to dwell on the positives that I see, and to use my very best energies in moving our college forward. Saint Augustine's College is too important for us as alumni to sit back and watch it go under. We simply cannot allow that to happen.

Where are we as a National Alumni Association? Progress is slowly being made. We are still searching for a volunteer to serve as Executive Director (without pay), until we can afford to hire a staff and lease an office location. We still need to organize additional local chapters and revitalize those who are listed on paper, but are not actively participating. We have requested all local chapters/affiliates of the National Alumni Association to secure an EIN number for the IRS, but only one has. We need to dramatically increase our regular memberships (dues are only \$30 per year) and we need to continue to build our life memberships (\$500 paid over a maximum of 5 years). Our paid membership is less than 600 alumni, even though 8,000 or more are eligible to join. We must increase our annual giving to the college, for both scholarships and unrestricted giving. The larger the number of alumni who give, the greater the advantage for the college in raising additional dollars from "outside philanthropists." Please consider a generous financial gift for the college during this fiscal year, and \$25 or \$50 won't go very far today.

My fellow falcons, I am still excited about the potential we have as an association, and as alumni of a great institution. I'm at the age now, where my life will not have very much meaning, if I can't see where I've made a difference on this earth in the lives of others before I leave here. I hope you will join with me in making a difference in the lives of students who are attending now, and are yet to enroll at Saint Augustine's College.

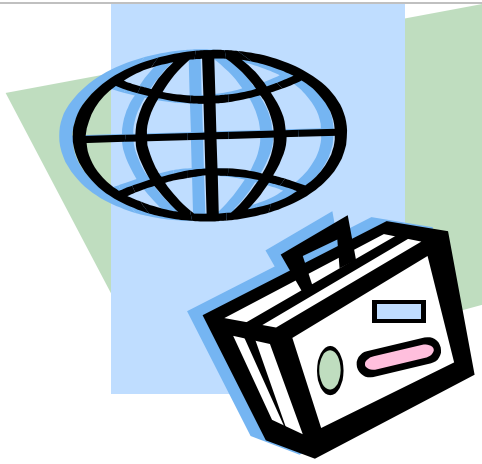

Ride with pride with the Saint Augustine's College Insignia License Plate.

The Office of Institutional Advancement and Development and the National Alumni Association of Saint Augustine's College are partnering to sponsor a campaign to authorize the North Carolina Division of Motor Vehicles to issue a license plate bearing the insignia of the College. The Division of Motor Vehicles, the College and National Alumni Association will approve the color and design of the plate.

The collegiate plate campaign is being introduced at a time when the cost of attending college is rising, but the amount of scholarship money available to students is not keeping pace. \$15 of every tag purchased is dedicated to academic or financial need-based scholarships for the College.

Any North Carolina resident can apply for collegiate plates. Please join us in this effort by lending your support to the College. **Put the plate on your car and let everyone know that you are a part of the Falcon team!**

The cost of the license plate is \$25 per year in addition to your regular registration fee.

Personalized collegiate plates cost \$55 in addition to the normal registration fee.

300 applications along with appropriate fees must be collected and forwarded to the Division of Motor Vehicles before the tag will be authorized.
